organisations told the people. They said it on the ramp of the German Reichstag, which the campaign "The Funeral or the Heavenly Four" had conquered once again. They said it on the Gendarme Market, on Hacke's market, on Alexander Square, on Kollwitz Square and in front of the Berlin central station.

The spectators were highly interested, vacillating like the character of Oskar Matzerath from Grass' novel "The Tin Drum", who was to be seen on the third lorry.

When the participants of the campaign at the Soviet memorial thanked the Soviet soldiers, Mrs Merkel was not admitted any longer. Wearing the blue shirt of her early years, the shirt of "Free German Youth" she had been sent back by force to her native town by other young fighters of the campaign.
